

### English

Linking to our topic work, we will begin by reading Snowy by Berlie Doherty and then “Chicco Chugg” by Janet Roberts, exploring alternative lives. We will learn to write information texts and leaflets, based around our topic knowledge, and also diary entries. Reading, Phonics and Spelling underpin the whole curriculum and will continue to be taught on a daily basis.

### Social and Emotional Wellbeing

Our topic for this term is ‘Healthy Minds and Healthy Bodies’, before looking back at our achievements and looking forward to next year.

### Knowledge of our World

Our topic combines a local study of Hungerford and canals, especially the Kennet and Avon Canal. It will involve historical, geographical and scientific study, looking at why the canal exists, the route it takes, how and why it was built and life for the people who worked on it. We hope to visit the canal, explore some of our local landmarks and canal history.

### RE

Our big question this term is based on Hindu beliefs. We will be asking how Brahman can be everywhere and in everything. We will then explore how pilgrimage forms an important part of Hindu life.

### Creativity

We begin with a focus on Monet and his water-themed art. We will use a variety of media including collage and printing to recreate work in his style. We will discover the Roses and Castles of traditional canal art. Linking with our topic, we will be challenged to design and make our own canal barges in miniature, testing their capacity to float and carry goods on a scaled down canal.

### Maths

The children will be building upon their knowledge and understanding of more formal written methods of calculation in all the maths operations. We will develop understanding of division and be using times tables. We will be making links with our topic wherever possible and be using data handling and measure to aid our Science.

### Science

We will revisit Forces through our Canal topic, exploring friction, gravity and motion, and look at the mechanics of levers, locks, and windlasses. This term’s topic is about plants and the environment. We will look at different habitats when we explore areas around the locality. We will look at what plants need to survive and how the different parts of the plant work together. We will look at how plants and animals adapt to their environments.

### ICT

Our skill focus this term is Communicating Information. The children will be researching our topics using the internet as one source, and finding different ways to communicate their findings.
