

English

We will start the term by writing Plays and Dialogues and turning a piece of Roald Dahl's writing into a script. We will then look at non-chronological reports in the form of game reviews! Muntjac will also focus on the work of David Walliams where we will attempt to write in his humorous style! Finally, the children will be writing some rather nonsense poetry after looking at the work of Edward Lear!

Science

This term's topics are States of Matter and Sound. We will explore how to sort materials and how some states can change. There will also be a focus on the water cycle to link to our Topic. We will also explore how sound travels and how we can change it. There will also be a fun focus on how we can make sounds through the use of various musical instruments!

Maths

The children will begin with work on subtraction skills and will move onto learning the formal method of calculation. We will be learning how measure both areas and perimeters. Also, we will focus on our fun fraction skills! The term will finish with some revision of our four calculation methods as we try to ensure we can use these all confidently.

Computing

We will look at coding through the mediums of Scratch and Studio Code.

PSHE

Our themes for the next two terms are Relationships, Health and Wealth and Going for Goals. We will explore the role of goals in our lives as well as how we can stay healthy both in body and in mind!

RE

We are looking at two major questions this term in R.E. Firstly, we will turn to Christianity and ask what it means for God to be both holy and loving. Afterwards, we will then look at Hinduism in the run up to the end of term.

Topic

We have two topics to cover this term. We will focus on Coasts to begin with and then move to a general look at WW2 and the effect of this on Britain and its coasts. We will study how coasts have come to be as they are now as well as looking at the importance of the Navy in the War. We will also look at how children were treated during WW2.

Music
