



Dear Parents and Carers of EYFS children,

Please see below an outline of the EYFS Home Learning Provision programme which is planned out for the weeks Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 and Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

In order to make access to the learning activities more manageable, the school will post information on the Monday of each week by 10.00am for the two weeks leading up to the Easter holiday.

### Home Learning EYFS

1. Phonics ~ 20mins
2. Maths ~ 20mins
3. Shared reading ~ 20mins
4. Project ~ 30mins

### Phonics

Phonics will follow the daily pattern of flashcards using letter tiles, reading key words, using letter names, word building using the grapheme of the day and writing dictated sentences.

### Maths

Maths starters should include counting to then back from 20, number bonds for 10 and writing numbers 1-20. Specific tasks will be given for each day.

### Project

Project work will involve elements of other areas of the Early Years Curriculum, such as art, construction, science or RE. A small amount of this work will be written but will mainly be practical.

### Shared reading

It is vital that you read to your child every day and discuss the characters and ideas in the story or information book. Children **MUST** also read daily, using e-books. These can be found on communications4all and on Oxford Reading Tree (ORT) websites (see below). We will direct you to a decodable comic on the Phonics Play website. The shared reading activities can be split into two or three parts over the course of the day if preferred.

All written work should be completed in the exercise book provided. Talk is also vital to a child's development to develop their vocabulary and understanding of sentence construction. A website is also included to support this (see below).
