



Dear Parents and Carers of Year 1 Children

Please see below an outline of the Year 1 Home Learning Provision programme which is planned out for the two weeks Monday 23rd March 2020 and Monday 30th March 2020.

In order to make access to the learning activities more manageable, the school will post information on the Monday of each week by 10.00am leading up to the Easter holiday.

Home Learning Year 1

1. Phonics ~ 20mins
2. Writing task ~ 20mins
3. Spelling ~ 20mins
4. Maths ~ 30mins
5. Project ~ 30mins
6. Shared reading ~ 10mins

Phonics

Phonics will follow the daily pattern of flashcards using letter tiles, reading key words, word building using the grapheme of the day and writing dictated sentences.

Writing task

The writing task will extend from phonics. Children will choose some of the words they made to write sentences of their own. This will be extended over the week to challenge the children to add exclamation marks or write a question using a question mark or develop their work into short narratives.

Spelling/key words for reading

Words for reading and spelling will be given each day. These will be taken from the Year 1 high frequency word list but will be supplemented with other key words. Children should use the look, cover, write, check method to learn spellings.

Maths

Maths starters should include counting to then back from 100, number bonds for 10 and 20 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Specific tasks will be given for each day with challenge tasks where appropriate.

Project

Project work will involve elements of other areas of the curriculum, such as science, geography, art or RE. A project will be set to be completed over the week with specific areas of the curriculum that **MUST** be included as well as suggestions to extend the work.

It is vital that you read to your child every day and discuss the characters and ideas in the story or information book. Children **MUST** also read daily, using e-books.
