Sika class had another fantastic and enjoyable school trip to the Water Park at South Cerney. To begin with they split into 2 teams and create 2 rafts which would be raced, to see who could reach the pier first without sinking. This required great team work, communication and a good knowledge of knot tying! The fabulous adults Mrs Armstrong, Mrs King, Mrs Davies and Mrs Smith encouraged the pupils to think about design and working together (despite it being 30 degrees!). After more drinks and topping up the sun cream, Sika tested their rafts and the results were hilarious, as they quickly realised you cannot all sit on one side of the raft without it capsizing! When we were eventually able to extract the pupils from the lake, we went for lunch in the shade and recuperated before the next activities. The first activity was to trial paddle boarding. The pupils tried paddle boarding by themselves and using a bigger board, where 6 of them could fit on and attempt to paddle simultaneously! Once the pupils found their rhythm, they were off! Once everybody had a go, the boards were lined up in the lake, the pupils had to leap from board to another without falling in the water! As you can see, Samuel was very successful! With only 30 minutes left, we decided to allow Sika to climb on the water assault course and continue to use the paddle boards until it was time to dry off before coming home. However, the lovely Mrs King was very kind and bought all of the children an ice lolly, which helped convince them to get change quicker! We had an amazing time and I hope that all the pupils take a lot of good memories away from today! As always, Sika Class were a credit to the school and their parents; we are very proud of them all!
