History: Terms 1 and 2

Looking at the timeline of events through the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Understand the differences between the ages.

Investigating what life was like through these ages.

Comparing how different life was between then and now.

A school trip to Stonehenge.

Music

We shall be using Charanga scheme for learning music theory and learning how to play the recorders.
