Expressive arts and design

Self portraits ~observing details and mixing colours, using natural materials. Exploring clay to form sculptures with the use of tools to add texture. Using construction kits to build houses and streets on large and small scale, showing and naming the main features. Christmas art and design. Autumn observational art. Music: Charanga – ‘Chant to the animals’. Inspiring artists this term: *Sol Lewitt, Goldsworthy, David Hockney.*

COMMUNICATION LANGUAGE & LITERACY

Sharing my likes and interests. Traditional tale ~ The Three Little Pigs ~ sequencing with actions (Talk 4 Writing) Role play indoors and out ~ the 3 pigs house, story maps and story scenes, inventing our own stories based on The Three Little Pigs. Developing speaking and listening through nursery rhymes. Who Lives in This House? The Mouse and the Apple ~ predicting endings. Owl Babies ~ me and my family. Small world story telling. Developing vocabulary through narratives and play. Phonics phases 2 & 3. Drawing club – early Literacy.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Exploring using our senses. Talking about significant events in life and family. **The Baby Project** ~ how do I look after a baby, what do I need, who will help me to look after a baby? Where I live ~ my home. What materials are used to build a house and why? Investigate 3 Pigs choices by performing simple tests. **IT** ~ Move Beebot along the street, stopping at each house. **RE** ~ Emmanuel Project: What makes every single person unique and precious? Why do Christians perform plays at Christmas? Christian values ~ thankfulness. How do we show that we are thankful for all the gifts God has given us? Related texts ~ A Wet and Windy Harvest for Puddles by Gill Vaisey, Tidy by Emily Gravett, Mouse and the Apple, The Leaf Thief. Harvest festival. Go on a walk to look for signs of autumn. Why do Christians perform nativity plays at Christmas? The Christmas story, giving thanks for Jesus. Baby's first Christmas.
