### History: Romans

#### Term 1 & 2: What was life like as a Roman Child?

- Know how Britain changed from the iron age to the end of the Roman occupation.
- Know how the Roman occupation of Britain helped to advance British society.
- Know how there was resistance to the Roman occupation and know about Boudicca.
- Know about at least one famous Roman emperor.

### Geography

#### Term 1 & 2:

##### What local geographical features are around us?

- Looks at maps of local area and see what geographical features are around.
- The Importance of the river kennet.

##### What are the European countries and capital cities?

- Know the names of and locate at least 8 European countries.

##### Geographical skills and fieldwork

- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.

### Computing

#### Computing Systems: Connecting computers and the Internet.

Connecting computers outcome: Identifying that digital devices have inputs, processes, and outputs, and how devices can be connected to make networks.

The internet outcome: Recognising the internet as a network of networks including the WWW, and why we should evaluate online content.

### Art:

Within Art this term, we will be looking at different art forms within the history topics. We will be looking at the artist Michelangelo and his Sculptures and Roman Mosaics.

### Design and Technology

We will be designing, building, and evaluating a roman catapult. We will look at the design and structure of a roman catapult. Looking at the materials and tools needed to build and then to build the final design and then to evaluate.

### Science

#### Physics: Light:

Know that dark is the absence of light; that light is needed to see and is reflected from a surface; and demonstrate how a shadow is formed and explain how a shadow changes shape; know about the danger of direct sunlight and describe how to keep protected.

#### Biology: Animals including humans:

Know about the importance of a nutritious, balanced diet Know how nutrients, water and oxygen are transported within animals and humans; know about the skeletal and muscular system of a human.

### PE

PE will be on Wednesday afternoon. So please ensure PE kits are in school for that day.

During this term they will be learning fundamental movement skills, Agility, balance, and coordination alongside learning different competitive games which are relevant to tournaments and festivals during the Autumn term.

**Music** We shall be using Charanga music curriculum. Within Term 1, we will be learning to play the recorder.
