Home Learning for Week 7 (week beginning 18.5.20)

This is our last week of home learning before half term, when new planning will not be set. You and your parents are entitled to a rest! However, if you did need to complete any of the tasks from the last few weeks, then I would be delighted! I do hope you are all well and trying to keep your learning going. Did you spot last week's deliberate mistake with phonics? This was rectified on Tuesday evening, but the prize for having eagle eyes and following the plan goes to Edward and his mum!

As always, concentrate on your Phonics/Reading, English and Maths work - use your mornings for these if you can.

Phonics and Spelling - see separate tabs for Plural Nouns and Dictation Sentences, with instructions and powerpoints.

This week the challenge is based around turning singular nouns into plural nouns. Try to remember the rules that we use, based on the word ending. Is it s, es, or ies? There are 2 powerpoints that will help to support this. There is also a quiz to complete to test your learning.

Day 1: Use Powerpoint 1 - rules for adding s or es to singular nouns to make plurals

Day 2: Use Powerpoint 2 - rules for adding s, es or ies

Day 3: Worksheet for writing out sentences and choosing correct plural

Day 4: Powerpoint quiz

Day 5: Dictation sentences for spelling

Please remember that if you are not feeling very confident, or just need some additional practise, do check out the Year 1 learning area.

English - see separate tab 🌸

Day 1 - Read a short fiction text; answer questions about a text; plan a story based on themes central to a familiar text.

Day 2 - Re-read a short fiction text to deepen familiarity; identify and use apostrophes to indicate possession; use a plan to compose a short story.

Day 3 - Revise understanding of expanded noun phrases; with help, read a more challenging short fiction text; write descriptively using expanded noun phrases.

Day 4 - Identify and use prepositional phrases to extend expanded noun phrases; read poetry.

Day 5 - Read further poetry; identify and write similes for description; write imaginatively using expanded noun phrases.

Maths - see separate tab 🧠

- Day 1** - Solve addition and subtraction word problems.
Day 2 - Add pairs of 2-digit numbers by partitioning.
Day 3 - Choose a suitable strategy when adding pairs of 2-digit numbers.
Day 4 - Measure capacity using uniform non-standard units.
Day 5 - Have an idea of the length of 15, 30 and 60 seconds.

Topic/Science 🦋🌻

Read and listen together online, "The Wild Woods" by Simon James, one of my favourite stories. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Wvomssxy_7A
 Discuss some of the creatures you might see out in the woods especially at this time of year. I have seen squirrels, but also heard woodpeckers hammering away, squawking pheasants, and seen rabbits and the occasional deer.

Read the online book "What's in the Woods?" from www.oxfordowl.co.uk

I want you to complete a writing task based on creating your own 'comic' story. To get ideas of what a comic layout looks like, you can use www.phonicsplaycomics.co.uk, select DIY and print 2 copies of one of the templates (one copy to be used to make a plan). Choose a layout with 6, 7 or 8 sections. If you cannot print from home, don't worry - draw your own using the ones on phonics play as a guide.

Your story title will be 'A Walk in the Woods' and you will need to think about what you see, hear or can do in the woods. As you research woodland habitats today, make a list in your home learning book under the headings of: - animals, plants, things you can do, other things that you can find.
