UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Exploring body parts and the senses. Talking about significant events in life and family. Compare features of different homes from around the world & from long ago. Observe old photographs of houses in the village, compare with houses now. Firework safety. What materials are used to build a house and why? Investigate 3 Pigs choices by performing simple tests. **RE** ~ Why is the word God so important to Christians? Christian values ~ thankfulness. How do we show that we are thankful for all the gifts God has given us? Related texts ~ A Wet and Windy Harvest for Puddles by Gill Vaisey, Tidy by Emily Gravett, Mouse and the Apple, The Leaf Thief. Harvest festival, an autumn walk. The Christmas story, giving thanks for Jesus. **IT** ~ Move Beebot along the street, stopping at each house, photograph natural materials for use in art-work.
