As a parent / carer I will do my best to:

- Work in partnership with the school, particularly in relation to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.
- Ensure my child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped to learn. On the first and every subsequent day of non-attendance, provide an explanation to the school by 8.50am.
- Not take holidays in term time (School expects **no** holidays to be taken in term-time).
